## RE: **23TP002 – 2023 Unified Planning Work Program Amendment #23-01 and** Amendment Number 1 to Funding Agreement 311568

Attached is an amendment to the 2023 Unified Planning Work Program to add funding for the Major Street Plan Constructability and Alignment Analysis Study. The Study was originally budgeted in 2022, but was not initiated. The original budgeted amount was for \$125,000. Due to delays in project initiation and additions to the scope, the revised budget is as shown in the amendment below.
