At its June 12, 2025 meeting, the Executive Policy Committee of the Rapid City Area Metropolitan Planning Organization approved a motion to support the City of Rapid City's FY25 SS4A Supplemental Planning and Demonstration Grant application to create a city-wide ADA Transition Plan, test new technologies for signal preemption for EMS, and complete road safety audits. These projects align with the initiatives being identified in the Safety Action Plan the City is developing.

The City of Rapid City is currently utilizing a SS4A Planning Grant to develop a Safety Action Plan that will provide the City clear direction on implementing innovative, evidence-based, low-cost, high-impact strategies to reduce the number of fatalities and serious injuries on our roadways.
